TMM Web Services that are interactively connected with the "**Note**" field have been revised; and the information in this field can also be viewed in the "Transactions Executed" and "Passive Orders" reports as well. The activities related with the "Detailed TMM Transactions" report and the "Member Orders" screen are still ongoing.

The screen and report revisions made in TMM will be put into effect as of **12 October 2017**; and Takasbank Money Market Manual containing such revisions is available through TMM Menu provided under our Bank's membership practices.
