Subject: About the Fee Schedule of Exchange Traded Funds in Equity Market Related Parties: Banks Brokerage Houses

Dear General Manager,

As it is known, in order to contribute to the development of the Exchange Traded Funds (ETF) traded in the Borsa Istanbul Inc. Equity Market, a 50% discount has been applied on the fees for clearing, creation and redemption transactions and dividend transactions received from ETFs since 2017.

At our Bank's Board of Directors meeting dated 23/12/2022 and numbered 444, it is decided to terminate the discounted fee schedule and to switch to the new fee schedule in order to comply with changing market conditions, the volume reached by ETFs and relevant decisions taken by Borsa Istanbul Group companies.

Within this framework; current fee schedule and the fee schedule to be effective as of 01/01/2023 are as follows:
